Director's Notes

I have been waiting for the right moment, and the right climate, to share this show with you. This is one of the reasons I do theatre. This show.

Godspell is more than Stephen Schwartz's love letter to faith discovered in youth. It is more than a retelling of the life of Jesus Christ. It is something larger, and far more human.

Theatre gives us the rare opportunity to step inside perspectives that are not our own. When we explored Fiddler on the Roof, The Diary of Anne Frank, or even Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, we engaged with different cultures, traditions, and beliefs. In doing so, we expanded our empathy. We became more human. Godspell asks the same of us.

In our telling, we have softened names and removed specific places from the Book of Matthew. What remains is something universal. These students are not portraying biblical figures. They are portraying versions of themselves that are sometimes lost. Lost in the chaos of the world. Lost in the emotional turbulence of growing into adulthood. Lost in the search for community, connection, and kindness.



Through this process, we have discovered that Godspell is not ultimately about Jesus alone. It is about how we treat one another. It is about compassion, generosity, and the courage to offer help. It is about building a community grounded in forgiveness, understanding, and shared responsibility.

Above all, it is about love.

Love is the answer to so many of the things that ail us. It is not loud or flashy. It is deliberate. It is chosen. And it is powerful.

Thank you for sharing your love with us tonight.

Director Andrew Hunsaker and his support team of education professionals provide a variety of experiences for students and fill a valuable community need for quality theater productions.

The program offers a full-range of academic opportunities, including theater acting, musical theater and production. It also features four performances throughout the year, highlighted by a three musicals — one large-scale, school-wide musical and

two musicals performed as in-class projects of the program's two musical theater companies — Hyperion and Eos.

Spanish Fork High has a rich devotion to Shakespeare. The Drama Dons have participated in the Shakespeare Festival sponsored by Southern Utah University, and have consistently placed in their division for everything from monologues to larger ensembles. The school also regularly performs a full Shakespearean play as its non-musical production.

The Drama Dons are Troupe 943 of the International Thespian Society, an honor society for high school, junior high and middle school theater students.
